The timeline will look different for each application based on how complete your application is and how quickly you can address issues once identified. However, generally there are four phases of the application review process, and every application will go through the process below.

Verification that applicant is in good standing with:

- NJ Department of Labor and Workforce Development
- NJ Department of Environmental Protection
- NJ Department of Children and Families
- NJ Department of Human Services
- NJ Economic Development Authority

Verification that:

- All required documentation has been submitted and is the correct documentation
- All required documentation meets eligibility requirements

PROJECT ELIGIBILTY CHECK

COST REASONABLE CHECK

Verification that:

- All improvements are eligible
- Furniture, Fixtures, and Equipment are eligible (if applicable)
- Budget and contractor quotes align, and costs are categorized correctly
- Timeline, Project Description and Project photos align

Verification that:

- Contractor quotes meet
 Federal Cost Guidelines
- Contractors and professional services are not debarred from receiving funds
