Program enabling property owners to borrow against the increased property value from energy efficient improvements.

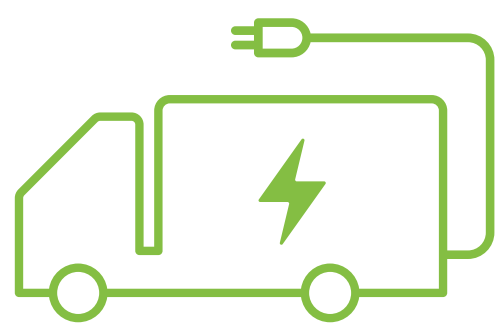
