APPLICANT CHECKLIST



The following items are required at the time of application.

Applicants will have fifteen (15) business days to provide any missing items.

REQUIRED ITEMS

Eligibility Assessment Tool - Utilize this resource to check your eligibility for this grant.
Tax Clearance Certificate - Obtain a current certificate from the NJ Division of Taxation. Instructions are available through NJ Premier Business Services .
Application Fee - \$1,000 non-refundable application fee due at the time of application.
Formation Documents - Submit formation documents for the development entity.
Receipts/Invoices Preparation - Collect and prepare all receipts/invoices related to eligible soft costs for reimbursement submission at the time of application to expedite the first disbursement.
Evidence of Site Control - Submit a copy of the deed confirming the name of the development entity is consistent with the name on the application.
Organizational Chart - Submit an organizational chart that demonstrates the developer owns at least 51% of the development entity.
Background and Experience of Applicant and Development Entity - Provide resumes of key members of your development entity, detailed documentation demonstrating the qualifications, professional history, and skills of everyone involved in your development.
Previous Experience Portfolio - Provide a project portfolio, similar in scope, demonstrating the developer's capacity to complete the proposed project.
Grant Funding Limits - The grant amount will not exceed \$200,000. Projects located in designated Opportunity Zones or Government Restricted Municipalities (GRM) may be eligible for an additional bonus of \$50,000.
Use the NJEDA Mapping Tool to see if your project site is located in a Designated Opportunity Zone and/or Government Restricted Municipality (GRM) in Atlantic City, Trenton, and Paterson. - Use map results to fill in block and lot - Use map results to identify if the project is eligible for the additional \$50,000 bonus
Construction Status - Ensure no construction has commenced before the application is submitted.
Detailed List of Eligible Soft Costs - Provide a detailed list of all incurred eligible soft costs.
Certificate of Occupancy - Include a copy of the certificate of occupancy for previously completed projects. *We will accept official documents from the municipality in lieu of a certificate of occupancy if they do not issue one.
Property Development Type - Ensure the project is for the development of mixed-use or commercial properties only.
Must be in good standing with the State of New Jersey
