This Certification must be submitted annually by the Grantee, beginning twelve (12) months after the date of execution of the Grant Agreement, to remain in compliance with the Small Business Liquor License Grant program for the NJEDA compliance period of five (5) years from the date of execution of the Grant Agreement, along with the Grantee's [WR-30](#) (Employer Report of Wages Paid) from the NJ Division of Taxation, payroll reports or equivalent documentation for the four (4) preceding quarters.
